Belstra Milling Scholarship

Description

Established in 2000. Scholarship for high school graduating seniors.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior
- be attending a two or four year post-secondary institution

Preference (but not limited to) Belstra Milling Company employees and relatives

Reverend Thomas E. Fox Scholarship

Description

Established in 2005. Scholarship for graduating seniors or graduate students who are registered members of Sacred Heart Church in Remington, Indiana.

Eligible students must:

- be a registered member of Sacred Heart Church in Remington, Indiana
- have been involved in community service activities
- demonstrate financial need

Preference will be given to applicants studying the diocesan priesthood or religious order of men or women.

Grace Pampel Education Scholarship

Description

Established in 2006. Scholarship for **Covenant Christian**, Benton Central, Kankakee Valley, North Newton, Rensselaer Central, South Newton, Tri-County, or West Central High School graduates. Adult education and non-traditional students eligible. Scholarship awards for graduating seniors pursuing degrees in the fields of agriculture, fine arts, music, or nursing.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior of Covenant Christian High School, Benton Central High School, Kankakee Valley High School, North Newton High School, Rensselaer Central High School, South Newton High School, Tri-County High School, or West Central High School
- be pursuing a degree in agriculture, fine arts, music, or nursing field of study

Earl H. Passwaters Agricultural Scholarship

Description

Established in 2012. Scholarship for **currently enrolled college students** pursuing a degree in the field of agriculture.

Vision Farm Management Scholarship

Description

Established in 2013. Scholarships for graduating seniors of Jasper, Newton, and surrounding counties pursuing a degree in an agricultural related field of study.

******Preference will be given to Vision Ag employees and relatives.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior (or graduate) of any Jasper, Newton (or surrounding counties) High School; non-traditional students may also apply
- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- be pursuing a degree in an agricultural related field of study

Wilbert A. Hamstra Scholarship

Description

Established in 2000. Scholarship for Kankakee Valley or **Covenant Christian** graduating seniors. Preference will be given to Hamstra Group employees and relations.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior of Kankakee Valley High School or Covenant Christian High School
- be pursuing a degree in the field of building construction technology or engineering (preferred but not required)

Dr. Cecil and Gladys Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Description

Established in 1994. Scholarship to graduates of all Jasper County and Newton County high schools pursuing medically related fields of study. Adult education and non-traditional students are also eligible.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior of any Jasper or Newton County High School; non-traditional and adult education students may also apply
- be pursuing a degree in medicine or other medically related field

Jackson Township Scholarship

Description Established in 2009. Scholarship for graduating seniors **residing in Jackson Township**.

Eligible students must:

- be a resident of Jackson Township in Newton County
- be a graduating high school senior
- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- be pursuing post secondary education at a college, university or vocational technical school

Renewable

Current/former recipients of this scholarship may re-apply each year during their course of study. Renewal is not guaranteed. Renewal dependent on maintaining a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA

Dale Stath Memorial Agricultural Scholarship (for Residents of Jasper County)

Description

Established in 2018. Scholarship for a graduating high school senior who is a **resident of Jasper County** pursuing a degree in agriculture or an agribusiness field.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior who is a resident of Jasper County
- be pursuing a degree in the field of agriculture or agribusiness
- be a member of FFA and/or 4-H
- have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

**Preference will be given, but not limited to, students pursuing a 4-year degree

LEAP Foundation Scholarship

Description

Established in 2020. Scholarship for graduating seniors who would like to further their education with a 2 or 4 year degree in the pig industry.

Eligible students must:

- be an Indiana High School Graduating Senior
- be pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree in the pig industry
- have a 3.0 minimum GPA. Priority will be given to student with a GPA of 3.5 or above (must provide official transcript)
- provide a list of extracurricular activities with description of the role played or office held
- write a 200 word essay on why a career in the pig industry is appealing to you
- provide a Letter of Recommendation (required) from one of the following:
 *A teacher who can attest to your potential for academic success
 *A coach, school administrator, or guidance counselor who can comment on your leadership

*An employer or leader in the community who can vouch for your character and commitment to others and your community

Chris LaCosse Scholarship

Description

Established in 2011. Scholarship for any graduating senior from a Jasper or Newton County high school pursuing a degree in the field of education.

Eligible students must:

- be a graduating senior of any Jasper or Newton County high school
- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- be pursuing a degree in the field of education
- provide an essay describing how they envision influencing children's lives once becoming a teacher
