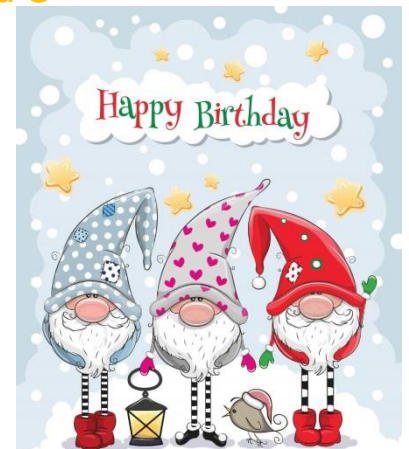

CCHS SERVICE WEEK DINNER DRIVE THRU (March 4, 5-7pm)

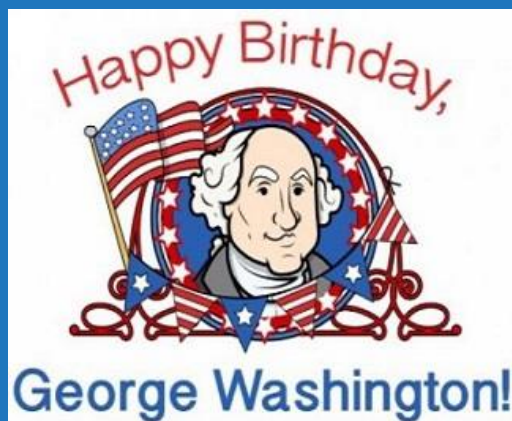
